

1 To show the grammatical function of a part of a sentence, function markers are used:

**nominative** Some sentence functions, such as the subject, are recognizable for the fact that they **don't** have a function marker. Absence of this marker is called the **nominative**.

**accusative** The sentence function of an object, along with several other functions, is recognizable by the N ending. This ending is called the **accusative ending** or simply the **accusative**.

**prepositions** Many sentence functions of different types can be recognized by various short words called **prepositions**.
